This print depicts these two saintly theologians with their traditional attributes. St. Thomas Aquinas wears his Dominican habit and holds a book of his writing and a miniature church. A sunburst shines on his breast. St. Anselm of Canterbury wears episcopal vestments and carries a crosier and a miniature ship.

Below them, a stylized vine and tiny plants and animals surround a banderole, on which is written *Fides Querens Intellectum* (Faith Seeking Understanding), the personal motto of St. Anselm and the general motto of all scholastic theology.
